**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
PUBLIC EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT RESOURCE SERVICE
A CALIFORNIA PUBLIC BENEFIT CORPORATION**

ONE: The name of this corporation is Public Education and Empowerment Resource Service.

TWO: This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes. The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized are twofold:

(1) to educate the public about the forces underlying the political, economic, and social structures that shape our nation and world, and

(2) to educate and inspire the public to reduce prejudice and economic inequalities and to foster a sense of global community based upon love and cooperation.

THREE: The name and address in the State of California of this corporation's initial agent for service of process is Frederick Burks, 1607 Francisco St., Berkeley, CA 94703-1216.

FOUR: (a) This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

(c) No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.
